## Introduction

The Office of the Fire Commissioner is a special operating agency of the Manitoba government performing a critical role in ensuring and maintaining Manitoba's public safety. The overall mission is to safeguard both persons and property from fire and life safety hazards through education, investigation, emergency response and code application.

The agency is seeking to fill an electrical inspector role with a licensed journey person (with "H" license in Manitoba or equivalent license from other jurisdictions) responsible for performing inspections of electrical installations to determine compliance to provincial codes, standards and guidelines. The position will be based out of the Winnipeg office and is expected to conduct inspections across Manitoba.

If you are looking for a rewarding and exciting career, this is a great opportunity to join our team.

The Manitoba government has a comprehensive compensation and benefits package which includes extended health care, health spending account, dental care, vision care, long term disability insurance, group life insurance, maternity/paternity leave, family related leave and a defined pension plan (some pension plans allow for portability between the Civil Service Superannuation Board and employers). ## Conditions of Employment:

- Must be legally entitled to work in Canada
- Licensed construction electrician ("H" license) in Manitoba or an equivalent license from other jurisdiction
- Must be able to obtain satisfactory criminal record check and child abuse registry check
- Must have a valid Manitoba class 5 driver's license (or equivalent license from other jurisdiction) and satisfactory driver's abstract
- Must be able to work alone and travel throughout Manitoba and occasionally in Canada and the US for extended periods of time
- Must be able to wear personal protective equipment including a respirator
- Must be physically capable of performing the duties and functions of the job including lifting heavy objects, kneeling, standing, climbing stairs and ladders, working at heights and entering confined spaces in various temperatures

Reporting to the Program Manager - Fire Safety Inspections, the position carries out inspections of new and existing electrical installations across Manitoba to ensure compliance with the requirements of various technical safety legislation and regulations. The position issues written orders, completes reports on inspection findings and monitors compliance on the same. The position further verifies the licensing and certification requirements of trade personnel.


