As the premier leader in firefighter, paramedic and emergency services training, the Manitoba Emergency Services College (MESCC) in Brandon, Manitoba is the Agency's arm in building, training and developing confident, competent firefighters, inspectors, investigators, instructors, officers and paramedics.

The College is seeking an experienced Mechanic who will be responsible for the service, maintenance, repair and diagnosis of mechanical defects and their causes in all vehicles, mechanical fixtures and equipment owned by the OFC.
