If you are interested in becoming a Certified Instructor, you must have successfully completed Emergency Services Instructor Level I (NFPA 1041), and co-taught for 30 hours or more.

- Certified Instructor Status Form
- Instructor Log Sheets (which are signed by the Lead Instructor attesting to the hours you taught)
- Attestation Form (either the Specialty Instructor or the Fire and EMR Instructor), signed by the Fire Chief or Training Officer
