Remember These Fire Safety Tips!



Fires are hot.

Check any door before you leave the room. If it's hot, use another exit.



Smoke rises.

If you must escape through smoke, get low and go under the smoke to the closest exit.



Get out and stay out.

Never go back into a burning building. That's a firefighter's job.
